

Response To COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

In trying to provide a safe environment, the following protocols have been implemented here:

- Our facilities are cleaned regularly.
- · High touched surfaces are being cleaned and disinfected daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, countertops, handles.
- In addition to hand soap available in the bathrooms, we have a supply of alcohol-based hand sanitizers available for use at every service time and location.
- Temporarily closing all the drinking fountains until further notice
- We plan to continue our meetings but are monitoring the situation and following recommendations from provincial and local government agencies.

The following are suggested for our attendants for virus prevention:

- Wash your hands often for at least 20 seconds, using plenty of soap and running water.
- Clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer often throughout the day.
- Disinfect items such as your cellphone, tablets, keyboard on a regular basis.
- Cover your mouth when you cough, and sneeze into a tissue or the inside of your sleeve or elbow, not your hands.
- Keep your hands away from your eyes, nose and mouth to keep germs from entering your body.
- If you have any symptoms of fever, cough, shortness of breath or sore throat, you must stay at home. This will prevent the spread of germs to other people you may come into contact with.
- Those who develop symptoms should stay home and call their health-care provider or 8-1-1 to discuss any need for testing and follow up.
